Mariano Rodríguez González is a doctor and professor of Philosophy at UCM (Complutense University of Madrid), co-director of the Nietzsche Complutense Seminar and the CLEPO Research Group ("Body, Language, and Power: Contemporary Readings from Nietzsche"). He is also a member of the "Nietzsche y la Poesía" research project; the RIEN (Ibero-American Network of Nietzsche Studies), and the SEDEN (Spanish Society of Nietzsche Studies). He has been a senior research fellow under the "Salvador de Madariaga" program at the Universidade Nova de Lisboa (Lisbon Nietzsche Group).

In addition to teaching Philosophy of Mind, he has conducted research on the works of thinkers such as Nietzsche, Freud, Wittgenstein, and María Zambrano. He has translated works by Derek Parfit and David Velleman and contributed to the Complete Works of María Zambrano.
