

Results of the project “Epigraphic Lexicon of Dacia” for the year 2016

Editing and publishing of the volume *Epigraphic Lexicon of Dacia*.

During the editing of the lexicon, the epigraphic material already gathered was further reviewed, verified, and, if necessary, corrected. Some articles were rearranged in order to create a more coherent dictionary or were developed in order to offer readers richer and clearer information. The work thus resulted is useful not only to researchers, but also to students, offering data not only about the Latin and Greek language (morphological classes documented, cases or modes used preponderantly, etc. - see infra some examples of words) attested in Dacia, but also about historical, political, military (see *Galli*), administrative (see *fiscus*), religious (see *Iuno*, *Ygíeia*) realities of the Roman Empire.
